## **Palo Verde Energy Education Center**

Buckeye, AZ April 18th, 2018 at 9.30am

This tour goes into more detail on nuclear power generation and Palo Verde. It is recommended for all even if you also go to the power station.



The Palo Verde Energy Education Center (EEC) opened in 2011. The main purpose for this facility is to serve as an emergency base of operations in the event of a crisis at the Palo Verde Nuclear Generating Station (PVNGS), which is conveniently located 22 miles away. During non-emergency times, the center is used as a technical and education facility. Information from the PVNGS is displayed via live data streams and monitored closely by employees at the facility.


They are able to communicate instantly with the individuals at the plant and other officials around the world if any issue arises at the nuclear plant.

At the center you will see digital maps of Palo Verde, Full size sample fuel rods, reactor models, emergency procedures, different reactor designs, power distribution full size model of a spent fuel container and the use of treated water.. This plant is 27 miles west of I-10.


