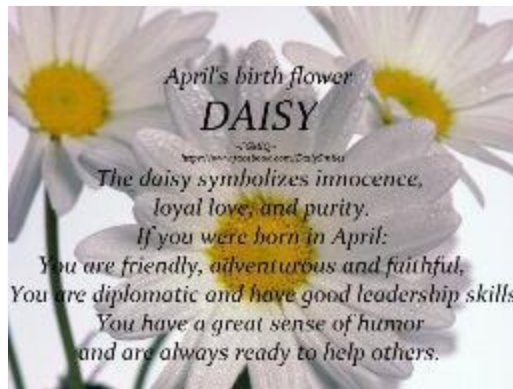

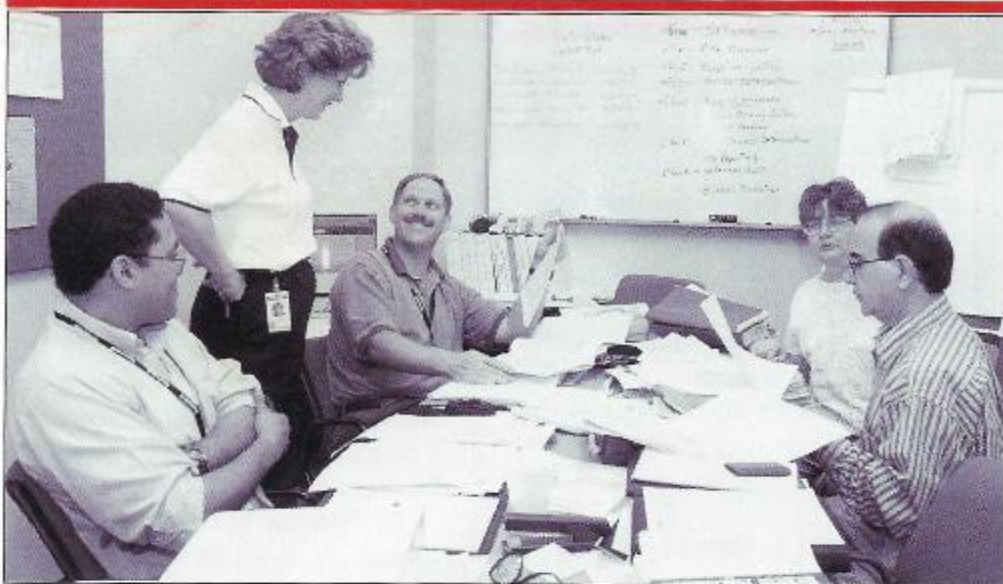

CES process procedures evaluated during audits

Process procedures throughout Commercial Electronic Systems-Phoenix were evaluated during two important audits which occurred in April.

Five Federal Aviation Administration auditors visited CES-Deer Valley and CES-Bell Road from April 4-14 for an Aircraft Certification Systems Evaluation Program audit.

The ACSEP audit focused on whether current manufacturing processes comply fully with FAA regulations.

These regulations cover areas such as quality control, failure reporting, parts

modification and record keeping.

“Honeywell is responsible for ensuring that the parts produced under our FAA production approval are 100 percent compliant to the FAA-approved design,” explained **Max Berghammer**, Regulatory Interface Office manager.

On April 18, more than 10 auditors from Boeing visited CES-Deer Valley and its supplier of circuit-card assemblies, EFTC’s Southwest Commercial Operations in Phoenix.

The auditors were charged with evaluating CES-Deer Valley compliance to specific sections of Boeing’s D1-9000

Desert Botanical Garden is a 140-acre botanical garden located in Papago Park, at 1201 N. Galvin Parkway in Phoenix, central Arizona.

Founded by the Arizona Cactus and Native Flora Society in 1937 and established at this site in 1939, the garden now has more than 50,000 plants, in more than 4,000 taxa, one-third of which are native to the area, including 379 species, which are rare, threatened or endangered.

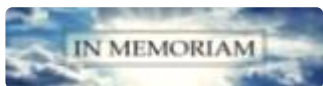
