Avionics Service Center in Long Beach has new, larger, electro-sigio and climate controlled quarters

LONG BEACH, California — Honeywell's Los Angeles Avionics Service Center, here, has moved into new, climate controlled quarters that are conveniently located near the Long Beach airport.

AERO ACTIVITIES CLUB

The new location in 1903 Obispo Avenue is now in use. It is staffed by ten people and has room for the Lasernav service, which is to be added early next year.

The local FAA avionics inspectors gave the new quarters their prompt approval. As a result, there was a minimal shutdown period and customer support continued without noticeable interruption.

The service center was moved into its new facility on Sept. 11, by a very reliable moving company. Despite this, the service center's staff carefully packed every customer-owned device at the old location and hand carried them to the new quarters.

The Obispo Avenue quarters are 68% larger than the previous location and include electro-static and climate control features that provide the maximum protection to the customers' devices as well as to the inventory used in the repairs. These features also provide the maximum assurance of reliable repairs and testing requirements.

The first floor has 2600 sq. ft. (241.5 sq. m) of conductive tile and matting to protect state-of-the-art static sensitive devices. Three 40 ft. (12.2 m) long grounding rods were driven into the earth under the laboratory areas and then connected to copper sheeting under the floor tiles. This provides individual station and peripheral test

equipment grounds and maximum protection against electromagnetic interference.

Transformer isolated circuits have also been installed to supply interference-

free power to critical test fixtures and equipment. In addition, the whole first floor is climate controlled. Air conditioning, humidity control, and Honeywell's electronic air cleaners provide protection against dust and static.
