



SW is starting ETOPS flights to Hawaii so Phoenix will be their main West Coast maintenance center as California is too expensive.





# Tovrea Castle

Never say never again. After 258 tickets purchased by the club for 14 visits; all have been sold for this popular tour. And there is still a waiting list! If you try to go as an individual you will find no tickets are available for the rest of this year.

The Aero Activities Club has purchased 48 additional tickets and allocated them to the people on the waiting list. Please note that the tickets in the past have all be allocated in days or weeks so procrastinators will miss out just like shopping in Costco. The Society has increased the price to \$20 and the club is adding \$2 per ticket for expenses for a total of \$22 each.

This is a private tour for Sperry, Honeywell and Garrett clubs. Tours are approximately 2 hours and include the historic Castle's main floor and basement, extensive grounds and cactus gardens surrounding the Castle. Most of the tour is outside riding a tram so dress warm. The tour starts at 9.30 am and the grounds are cool. The tour is wheel chair accessible but no electric scooters are allowed.
