Honeywell wins IRS contract for Boeing 737-300 aircraft

Boeing's Renton, Washington, facility is the scene of the signing.

SEATTLE, Washington — The Boeing Commercial Airplane Co. has chosen Honeywell's ring laser gyro inertial reference system (IRS) for its next airplane, the 737-300.

On Sept. 15, after more than a year of technical and cost tradeoffs, Boeing selected Honeywell's IRS.

The heart of Honeywell's IRS for the 737-300 is the inertial reference unit, now in production for both the Boeing 757 and 767 aircraft. Certification of Honeywell's IRS on the Boeing 767

on July 30th marked the first approval of a laser gyro inertial system for airline use.

The initial contract award is for 100 shipsets, with an option for 200 additional shipsets. Production deliveries are scheduled to begin in 1984 for installation on the first 737-300 airplane to be delivered to USAir.

The Boeing 737-300 is a re-engined and longer bodied version of Boeing's earlier and very successful 737 series, of which more than 1000 have been

sold. It is designed to accommodate up to 148 passengers, and its potential market is estimated to be in the hundreds.

Boeing is already considering two additional 737 derivatives, designated the 737-400 and 737-500. Studies include modified, or new, more efficient wings, and a digital avionics suite that includes the IRS. Together they could represent an additional potential market for Honeywell.

Seat mile costs is forum's focus

BLOOMINGTON, Minnesota — The Air Transport Association's 1982 Engineering and Maintenance Forum, held here on Oct. 5-7, focused on "Producing Seat Miles at Lower Costs — A Critical Objective — Now."

Coveted "Nuts and Bolts" awards were presented to Lyle Raverty, group vice president, Airline Technical Operations, Air Canada, and Ed Thomas, vice president-engineering, Air Transport Association, for their significant contributions to the air transport industry thru the years.




