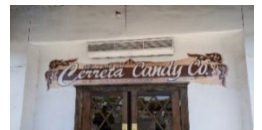

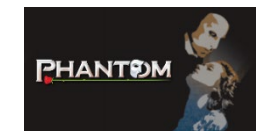

# Manistee Ranch Park

**Private tour Saturday Nov 9<sup>th</sup> at 10am**



## History - [Historic Manistee-ranch](#)

Built in 1897 by a wealthy lumber baron from Wisconsin named Herbert W. Hamilton, Manistee Ranch began as a 320-acre spread along what is now Northern Avenue. Hamilton sold the place to Louis M. Sands, a prominent Arizona businessman and rancher, in 1907, and it stayed in the Sands family until it was sold to the Glendale Historical Society in 1996.

Today the ranch is on the National Register of Historic Places, and its four buildings – a garage, office, barn and house – can be visited by anyone who wants to get a little taste of Glendale history.

Guests will be treated to a 7000 square foot home decorated in antique furnishings that are original to the home or that were collected from within the city. The basement houses a collection of photographs, Glendale grammar school items and old farm equipment that was used on the ranch.

The farm equipment was utilized mainly to harvest feed for the livestock, which included cattle, sheep, horses, ducks, and chickens.

The Sands family also grew citrus and dates on the ranch. In the 1920's workers would harvest the dates and store them in a date house next to the rose arbor. The dates were then sold for 25¢ a pound. Today, the ranch is home to 11 different species of palm trees including Hayany, Bent Kebella, Medjoul, Braim, Barhe, Zadhi, Maktoom and Deglet Noor, to name a few.

The date grove has been turned into a garden by the City of Glendale, where visitors can sit and meditate among the palms, some of which are more than 100 years old.

And Manistee's owners were not just ranchers. Through the years, the Sands family made significant contributions to the city. Before World War II, they were the largest employer in the city. And after World War II, they leased a portion of the ranch's acreage for Glendale's first mall – Valley West Mall, 52nd Avenue and Northern Avenue, Glendale, Arizona 85301.

The parking lot is on the west side of 51st Avenue just south of the businesses at Northern Avenue.

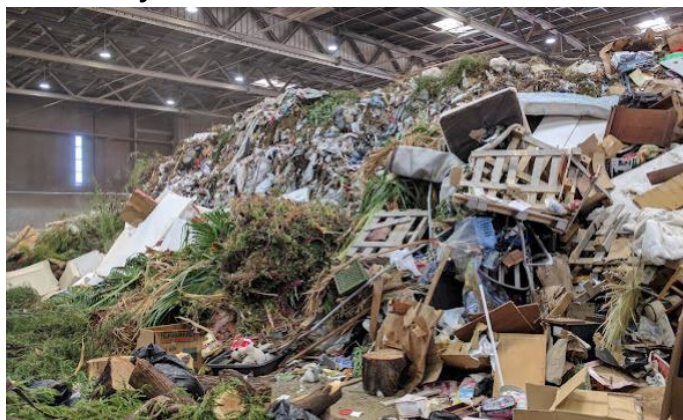

### ***Zero Waste Team Education***

The City of Phoenix has goals to reach 50% waste diversion by 2030 and zero waste by 2050, consistent with the goals set by the City's [Climate Action Plan](#). To reach these goals, Phoenix seeks to develop the circular economy and maximize recycling and reuse efforts to further divert resources away from the landfill. Our efforts will lessen environmental impacts by reducing the amount of greenhouse gases entering the atmosphere, while creating healthier communities, and spurring economic activity.

In order to reach the city's zero waste goal by 2050, the Zero Waste team provides education and community outreach to teach the community about waste diversion. These methods include group tours of the city's North Gateway Transfer Station and Materials Recovery Facility (MRF), educational presentations to schools, neighborhood and community meetings and hosting informational booths at community events.

Now you can experience the sight, sound and smell of recycling at the North Gateway Transfer Station. The address is 30205 N Black Canyon Hwy, Phoenix, AZ 85085. Gate 3. I have organized a group tour on Thursday January 9<sup>th</sup> at 10am. The tour lasts 1 hour.

## *Insight into our History*



### **Another piece of history from Sperry.**

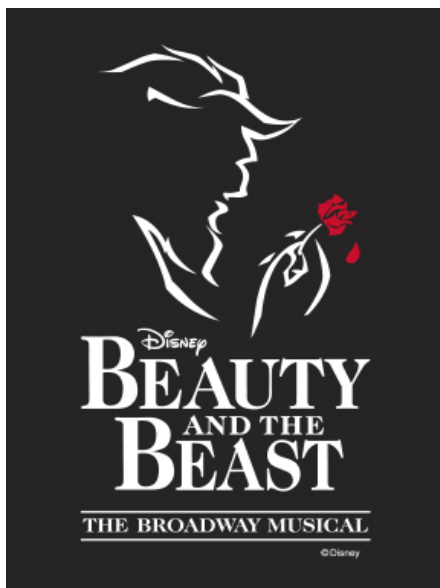
The TERN-100 was an Area Navigation (RNAV) system introduced in the mid 1970's, featuring several firsts in aviation; a 2-megabit hard drive with a fixed head for each track, that stored the operating program as well as a database with airports, waypoints, airways and approaches.

The CDU featured a scratchpad line (the small one) and LED illuminated line select buttons. It fit in the space of an inertial CDU. This FMS predecessor also had coupled VNAV and was first fitted on the Saudi Royal 707, followed a few years later by their 747. There were also corporate Gulfstream and Falcon operators.

This system evolved into the Boeing, Douglas and Airbus FMS's. BCAS introduced another generation in 1987 which was standard fit on the G-IV, Falcon 900, Hawker 800 and Canadair CL601-3A. The NZ-800 was fitted to a Continental Express ATR-72 and flew the first FAA Part 25 approved GPS approach into Aspen, CO on Dec 17th, 1993. 40th anniversary this month!

The Desert Botanical Garden has free admission on the second Tuesday of the month from the hours of 8-6 PM. The garden and the neighboring Phoenix Zoo are accessible from the bus line; however, not by the light rail.

Best advice is to check the bus schedule, as times and bus numbers are subject to change.

Desert Botanical Garden is a 140-acre botanical garden located in Papago Park, at 1201 N. Galvin Parkway in Phoenix, Central Arizona.

Founded by the Arizona Cactus and Native Flora Society in 1937 and established at this site in 1939, the garden now has more than 50,000 plants, in more than 4,000 taxa, one-third of which are native to the area, including 379 species, which are rare, threatened or endangered.

All guests (members or general admission guests) are required to register and have a timed-entry ticket prior to entry to the Garden.

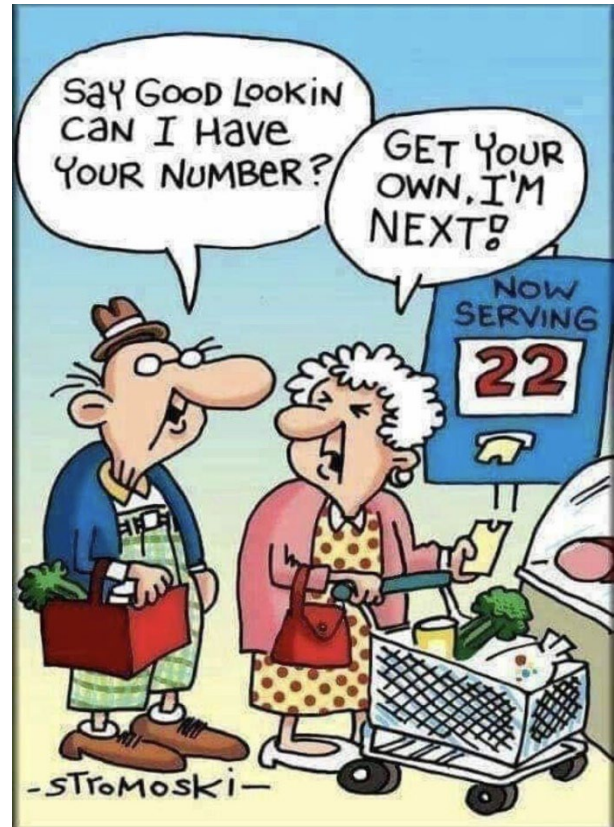
