It's party time. Spring is here and time for our signature event the Spring Picnic. Last year over 140 members signed up and about 134 actually attended. This is the most attended event we hold each year where you can meetup with old friends and make new ones. The event is free for members plus one significant other. Additional guests are \$10 but if they are eligible to join the club they can join on the spot for \$5 and get a free lunch. As stated last month our costs to rent the Ramadas has increased so our actual cost per member approaches \$10 so this year we will have a donation jar to offset the costs. If you are able, please contribute any amount.

Several people have asked me if their friends are eligible to join the club as they are still working or maybe now working for another company. The club is for Pre-retirees and retirees of Honeywell and includes it's subcontractors. For example:










ABT - Phantom was a wonderful Success

Desert Botanical Gardens

Free admission days, Second Tues of each month - 8AM - 6PM



The Desert Botanical Garden has free admission on the second Tuesday of the month from the hours of 8-6 PM. The garden and the neighboring Phoenix Zoo are accessible from the bus line; however, not by the light rail.

Best advice is to check the bus schedule, as times and bus numbers are subject to change.

Desert Botanical Garden is a 140-acre botanical garden located in Papago Park, at 1201 N. Galvin Parkway in Phoenix, <u>Central</u> Arizona.

Founded by the Arizona Cactus and Native Flora Society in 1937 and established at this site in 1939, the garden now has more than 50,000 plants, in more than 4,000 taxa, one-third of which are native to the area, including 379 species, which are rare, threatened or endangered.

All guests (members or general admission guests) are required to register and have a timedentry ticket prior to entry to the Garden.




