

1967 Archbishop Wilhem establishes the Senate of Priests, Office of Religious Education, & Liturgical Commission




1982 **Archbishop Francis John Spence** Appointed Archbishop 24 April 1982

Opening of the Volunteer & Lay Employee Screening Office


