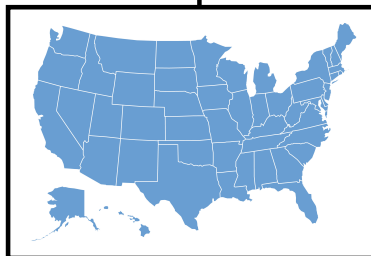
Meet your new ALJC world missionaries to New Zealand
