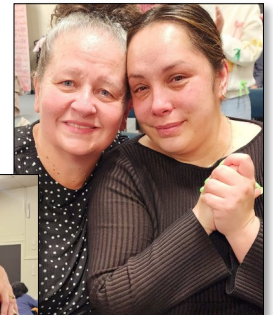

We have been busy in August with services and fellowship. Winter is coming to an end and brighter days are ahead. Sister Erwin attended a national ladies retreat on the south side of Auckland in early August. There was a tremendous outpouring of God's presence and delivering power of the gospel. Hearts were mended and lives were changed. Several were filled with the Holy Ghost for the first time.

We have been working on Sister Erwin's New Zealand residency visa. She has a visitor's visa for now. We have submitted all of the paperwork and paid the fees; now it is just a matter of waiting for the approval of her residency visa. We don't expect any issues, but the process just takes time. On her current visitor's visa she is required to leave the country every 6 months (end of September). This is a great added expense that is not in our monthly budget.
