

After this date, subject to places still being available, entry fees will be increased by 10%.

- 8 Once the Entry Form has been accepted and registration confirmed by the Committee to the exhibitor, the exhibitor is obliged to pay the total amount of his/her invoice within the delay indicated. Exhibitors who cancel their participation before the last registration date must pay 50% of their invoice.
