### FUNDS FOR PURCHASING THE BASE

Dear friends and supporters,

Some of you may have heard of The Base. This is a lot in town with several buildings on it that different missions have been using for several years for humanitarian aid work.

We, IBA mission, had been renting this facility as a men's home, shop, and storage place before the war. Now we operate a mechanic shop to service vehicles used for humanitarian work, tractors, and grain dryers. In 2025, we started a feed mill to provide the chicken feed used in our chick distributions.

Since the beginning of the war, some missions have begun using this space to store and package food parcels to support families affected by the conflict. The *Southwest Regions of the Nationwide Churches* is currently using part of this facility for packaging and for housing groups of volunteers involved in this project.

In the past four years, we have invested a considerable amount in remodeling this facility for the rising needs in the country. This place has been a great blessing for us and

our community of missions, providing many a place to lodge and work.

About three years ago we tried to buy the Base, but due to faulty paperwork this was not an option. Now, the good news is that **the legal work will soon be in place to enable us to move towards purchasing this place.** Since we believe this place is indispensable for the future of the humanitarian program in Ukraine, we would like to ask your support in allocating the necessary funds to acquire this place. We are estimating the cost of the Base to be about \$80,000.
