MESSAGE FROM THE BOARD

New Board Members

At the November 8th annual meeting Debra Johnson, John Clarke and Jennifer Fuchs were elected as the new Glen Laurel Board members for a one year term. At the November 15th Special Meeting of the Board of Directors, Debra Johnson was elected President, Jennifer Fuchs was elected Vice President, and John Clarke was elected Secretary/Treasurer. The Board is in the process of reviewing all existing contracts for the HOA (lake, landscaping, newsletter, website, pool, lake management etc.) and is renegotiating contracts where possible to realize any possible cost savings.

The directors are also focused on addressing issues with the fencing, working with the MUD Board on lake management, updating bylaws and improving the financial health of the Glen Laurel HOA. They will be working with the new Glen Laurel (GL) association attorney to conduct a complete review of the current bylaws and re-write any sections that may be outdated, not compliant with new Texas Property Code laws or may not be in the best interest of the GL community. There will be more details on that after the beginning of the year.

Glen Laurel Financial Update

The Balance Sheet presented at the 2012 annual meeting showed that the association had \$93K in the operating expense account, which means that the GL Homeowners Association could potentially run out of funds within the next 90-120 days based on the current budgeted expenditures. Since the 2013 dues are to be mailed by January 31, 2013 we are hoping we can avoid any shortfalls in operating funds.

The Board is reviewing all existing contracts for landscaping, lake management, newsletter, pool management and the website and renegotiating contracts where possible to get cost savings.

There were no separate savings accounts or CD's for reserve funds shown on the Balance Sheet presented at the 2012 annual meeting and the 2010 and 2011 audit reports raised a concern about this and recommended a reserve study be completed. We plan to conduct an analysis of reserves and plan to address the issue of the cap on the \$425 maintenance fee which is not adequate to support the community expenses, reserves and other required maintenance such as the fence replacements. More details on this will follow after the beginning of the year.

Kempner After School Tutorials

Kempner will start having buses for after school tutoring every Monday and Wednesday. These buses are only for students staying for after school academic tutoring. Buses will leave Kempner at 4:30 p.m. to take students home. The bus schedule can be found online on Kempner's website.

-Session I of tutoring 2:45-3:30 -Session II of tutoring 3:35-4:20 -Students can go to 2 different subjects or stay in 1 subject the entire time.

Students must be in tutoring the entire time if they are riding a FBISD bus home. Students sign up in the Commons each morning on the day of tutoring on the signup sheet (must have Kempner ID present to sign up for tutoring and board the bus). On Wednesday the school will also have a retesting room separate from tutoring for students who need to retest. This specific tutoring is district-funded and is not meant to replace tutoring that has already been occurring on campus, particularly for higher level AP-type courses.

GLEN LAUREL SAMPLE RESERVE STUDY *Chart does not show all GL assets

Below is a reserve sample study that shows the assets of the community, the replacement cost and the estimated life remaining of those assets. The sample reserve study shows what it costs to repair and/or replace many of the things that may break or wear out over time such as the lake fountains, pool deck, pool plaster, playground equipment, signage, irrigation or replacing trees or other landscaping and the useful life and remaining life of those assets. After the Reserve study is complete we will provide more information on this issue.



GLEN LAUREL FENCE UPDATE

The Board has received a lot of feedback from the homeowners about the need for the fences to be replaced. Recently, surveys were conducted for fences along W. Airport, Burney, Mason and Florence that show the fences are on the HOA property and not on individual homeowner property as previously stated. Therefore, the required maintenance for these fences is the responsibility of the HOA and would be paid for out of HOA funds. The replacement cost for the fences may be up to \$800,000 depending on materials chosen (cement, FenceCrete, cedar etc.). The Board is in the process



of getting bids from several companies on the fence replacement and will work with the fence committee to make final recommendations for this project to move it forward in 2013. We want to thank the volunteers on the fence committee for offering their time to help move this project forward.

Due to the current lack of reserve funds it is more likely that the fences will have to be done in a phased approach between 2013 and 2014 to make the project more affordable for all homeowners.

We are currently evaluating several methods for funding the fence replacements that may include a combination of a special assessment, increase in annual maintenance fee and any cost savings on current contract services. We plan to start with W. Airport and Florence and will address the fences on Burney and Mason in the next phase. Burney specifically was not chosen in the first phase due to the current road construction which is expected to continue into 2013:

W. Airport 2013

- Cement sound wall to be funded by special assessment
- Targeting construction for August 2013, pending homeowner vote by March 2013

Florence 2013

- 8ft cedar fence to be funded from savings from re-negotiated contracts and increases from annual assessment. The revised annual assessment to be voted on as part of bylaw revisions in 2013.
- Targeting construction for late 2013, no special assessment planned for Florence at this time

Burney 2014

- Fence materials and funding TBD in next phase of fence project
- Fence construction to begin after road construction is complete, scheduled for 2014

Mason 2014

- Fence materials and funding TBD in next phase of fence project
- No special assessment planned for Mason at this time

We expect to have all bids submitted by mid-December and will make final decisions about contractor selection and design for the W. Airport section of the fence project by the end of January 2013. We did make a request to the city of Sugar Land to assist with funding and the request was rejected.

The City of Sugar Land has streetscape standards that *(continued on page 5)*

recommend the type of sound wall fencing that can be constructed including restrictions on fence height, color, materials and appearance. The fence shown below meets those streetscape standards and is being considered for W. Airport:
