SPRING TIME MAINTENANCE

Take advantage of the wonderful weather and longer days to do some maintenance and to get some important home projects done. They improve the curb appeal of your home and prevent you from getting one of those deed restriction violation letters in the mail.

To properly maintain your home, here are a few reminders:

- Clean out gutters and downspouts from leaves and debris
- Repair & secure any loose gutters
- Pressure wash or remove mildew from the exterior of your home and fence
- Repair any siding or damage caused by small critters
- Mailboxes need to be straightened, cleaned and painted (with approved colors)
- House and curb numbers need to be visible
- Repair any loose pickets or replace any missing pickets
- Replace rotten or sagging fences

Make sure to review your deed restrictions and approved materials list under the DOCUMENTS tab on www.glenlaurel.net. As part of normal spring procedure, the management company will begin to send. Certified Demand Letters to any homeowners with lawns which continually remain unmaintained. A Certified Demand letter allows for the Association and its landscaper to enter upon homeowner property, perform any maintenance required and bill all associated costs back to the homeowner. With spring showers headed our way, make sure to stay on top of your lawn maintenance schedule to avoid a lawn out-of-control. This will ensure you are doing your part in keeping our neighborhood looking beautiful.

We are always trying to find ways to make our community park as inviting and fun as we can for all our residents. Our community park has always been a great place for our homeowners to get to know each other, enjoy each others company and now share the love of books and reading. PICK UP AFTER YOUR PETS

People not picking up after their pets is a problem. We want to encourage people to clean up what their pets leave behind because it can contaminate the area around us, and it's also a common courtesy to your neighbors to clean up after your pets.

Please be courteous and help clean up after your pet every time you walk them around the neighborhood. Take advantage of the several community dog waste stations located around the lake on the Imperial Canyon Dr. playground area.

If the stations are low in bags or the trash can needs to be emptied out, please contact Sterling Management and we will notify our landscapers to take care of it right away.

City of Sugar Land Ordinance

Sec. 3-13. - Animal waste disposal.

(a) It is unlawful for an owner or person having control of an animal to permit the animal

to defecate on private property unless the person immediately removes and properly disposes of the feces. (b)It is unlawful for an owner or person having control of an animal to walk the animal on private property without

carrying at all times a suitable container or other suitable instrument for the removal and disposal of animal feces. (c)Prior to filing a complaint with the city, the person whose property has been defecated on must give written

notice to the owner or person having control of the animal that the animal defecated on the property and the owner or person having control of the animal failed to immediately remove and properly dispose of the feces. A copy of the written notice must be presented to the city at the time of filing the complaint.

(d)It is a defense to prosecution under this section that the animal is a specially trained dog that is being used by a blind individual.

(e)It is a defense to prosecution under this section that the animal defecates upon private property owned by the owner or person having control of the animal.

(Ord. No. 1722, § 1, 12-16-2008)

ALLIGATOR SPOTTED IN LAKE

We have received reports of a small alligator spotted in Lake C (Burney and West Airport). Glen Laurel HOA is aware of this situation and has contacted the City of Sugar Land and the Texas Parks and Wildlife requesting the removal of the alligator. Unfortunately, feeding, harassing, injuring or removing wildlife, including alligators, is against the law. They will not go out for animals in their natural habitat unless they are a nuisance. Texas Parks and Wildlife is the only authority that can deem an alligator dangerous because of their protected status.

Remember: Be cautious and keep your distance around the lake, this is for your own safety and the animal's safety. Please click on the link below for more tips in coexisting with wildlife.

GREEN WASTE REMINDERS

Help us help you, Sugar Land! We've gotten a lot of reports of missed Green Waste pickups from Republic Services, even though you may have set your green waste out on time. We want to remind you that clear or translucent bags are **REQUIRED**. Items placed in bags that aren't clear or translucent won't be picked up.

The City created the Clear Bag mandate to increase process efficiency and to ensure that we are eligible for federal reimbursement after declared disasters, so it's incredibly important that everyone is on board! When residents put out green waste that exceeds the amount allowed per household or isn't in a compliant bag or container, it delays service to the rest of the city. The City and Republic Services are diligently working to keep up with the increase in volume, but compliance violations can further delay service. BULKY WASTE PICK UP HAS CHANGED

NO HEAVY TRASH PICKUP ON 1ST MONDAY OF EACH MONTH!!!!

In January 2023, the City changed the Heavy/Bulky waste Schedule in Glen Laurel HOA from once-a-month pickup to PICKUP ON CALL ONLY!!!

DO NOT PUT OUT YOUR HEAVY TRASH UNLESS YOU CALL FIRST!!! <u>THE CITY WILL NOT PICK IT UP!!!</u> Bulky waste service is provided on a flexible on-call basis.

- The service allows residents to schedule 12 bulky waste collections per year by contacting Republic Services Customer Service at 713-726-7307 or via email at **sugarland@republicservices.com**.
- The City offers 3 additional bulky waste collections following the Thanksgiving, Christmas, and New Year's holidays at no additional cost.
- Additional bulky waste collections are available for a fee. Fees must be paid prior to scheduling the service.

Guidelines

- Set bulky items out by 7 a.m. on collection day but no earlier than 6 p.m. the evening before.
- Residents may place up to five cubic yards of bulky waste out for collection on their bulky waste service day.
- Bulky items should be set out at the curb at least four feet from other objects.
- Do not place items in garbage carts for bulky waste collection. Items should be placed directly at the curb.

Landfill Drop-offs

Residents also have access to free landfill drop-offs at **Blue Ridge Landfill - 2200 FM 521 Road, Fresno, Texas** The landfill accepts household solid waste items from 4 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Friday and from 5:30 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. Saturday.

- Residents are allowed one free visit a month to dispose of up to 3 cubic yards
- Visitors are required to provide a valid driver's license and utility bill upon entry
- All visitors will be required to wear a hard hat and safety vest
