- Sidewalks are designed and installed to keep children and pedestrians out of the roadway, and when someone parks their vehicle blocking them, it forces people into the roadway, which can be dangerous.

Texas Transportation Code 545.302

(Parked blocking the sidewalk)

“STOPPING, STANDING, OR PARKING PROHIBITED IN CERTAIN PLACES. (a) An operator may not stop, stand, or park a vehicle:

- (1) on the roadway side of a vehicle stopped or parked at the edge or curb of a street;
- (2) on a **SIDEWALK**;
