City of Sugar Land Update - August 19, 2026

Green Waste Collection Changes Coming in 2027



Beginning **January 1, 2027**, Sugar Land is updating how green waste should be prepared for curbside collection. Grass clippings, leaves and other soft green waste will need to be placed in certified compostable bags or reusable containers labeled “Green Waste.” Clear bags will no longer be accepted. Small branches and limbs should be bundled with compostable string or cord and must meet the City’s size and weight requirements. Residents who use lawn care services are encouraged to make sure their contractors are aware of these updated requirements and collection schedules.

Effective Jan. 1, 2027

Soft Green Waste should be placed in a certified compostable bag or a reusable container clearly labeled “Green Waste”.



Effective Jan. 1, 2027

Clear plastic bags will not be accepted for green waste collection.

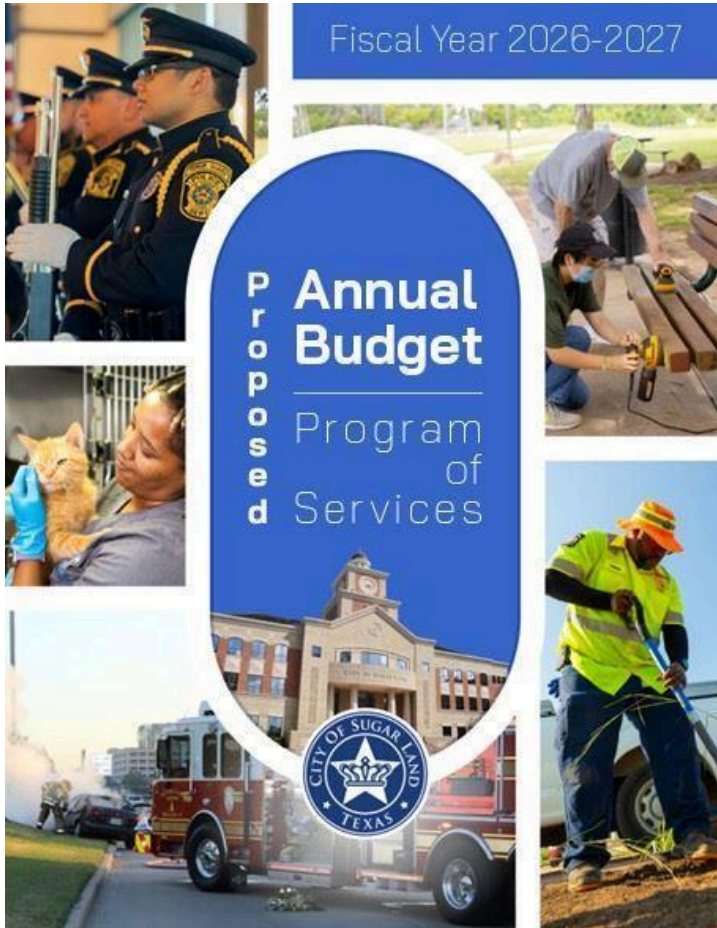


Effective Jan. 1, 2027

Small branches and limbs must be bundled with compostable string or cord (no wire), less than 4 feet long and under 40 pounds per bundle
