# MY CORE BELIEF...



- EAHS is one of the twenty-two high schools within the DeKalb County School District and serves all high schools.

### DEKALB COUNTY SCHOOLS' GRADUATION RATES SOAR TO AN ALL-TIME HIGH

The Dekalb County School District's (DCSD) graduation rate reached an all-time high in 2024. The four-year graduation rate is now 79.1%, up 3.3 percent from 2023 and a whopping 20.5 percent from 2011.

The district goal 2025-2026 was to increase graduation rate from 79.1% to 83%



### COLLABORATIVE CALIBRATED VISIT


### **Purpose:**

    - Total of 8 credits for summer sessions


# **JANUARY 7, 2025**






### 2023-2024 Comparison






