

Giant Sequoia Care

In Ground

- -Full sun
- -Well-draining, sandy, loam soil
- -Evergreen fertilizer in spring
- -Plant minimum 15 feet from other trees or structures
- -Mulch heavily. Do not mulch within 3 inches of the trunk.

In Container

- -Full morning sun or Partial sun throughout the day
- -Citrus/Cactus soil
- -Evergreen Fertilizer in spring
- -Re-pot/Up-pot every year or clean out soil, trim roots, and top to keep small and re-pot in the same container.

*Do not use store-bought general-purpose soils when keeping your tree in a container, you will kill your tree!

*Protect potted trees during the winter months by mulching around them or using common frost coverings from the store. DO NOT BRING YOUR TREE INSIDE HEATED SPACES DURING THE WINTER, YOUR TREE NEEDS TO SLEEP.

^{*}Young trees turn a maroon like color during the winter months. Your tree is not dead, its sleeping.
