Please keep your camper home if they show any signs of illness, including fever, vomiting, or other contagious symptoms. Campers must be **symptom-free for 24 hours** before returning to camp.

### Emergency Protocol

- A fully stocked first aid kit is available on-site at all times.
- In the event of a serious emergency, 911 will be called immediately.

- Parents and guardians will be notified promptly via the emergency contact provided at registration.
- Emergency contact information is **required** at the time of enrollment.
