## About GER

The Georgia Easy Riders (GER) RV CLUB is a non-profit, family-oriented Recreational Vehicle (RV) organization registered with the State of Georgia. Located in the NAARVA Southern Region and founded in July 2004 with ten (10) RV's. Today our membership has increased to thirty (30) RV's.

## Membership Criterial

To become a member of the GER RV CLUB, one must be of good moral standards and own (or have access to) a Recreational Vehicle (RV), such as a motor home, mini-motor home, camper, or trailer, that is self-contained. All prospective members must be a National African American RV Association (NAARVA) member in good standing before becoming a member of the GER RV Club.

Potential members must attend at least two "meet and greet" weekend camp outings. These must be either two consecutive meetings or two meetings within a six-month period (e.g., 2 of 3 bi-monthly meetings). When an opening becomes available, the Membership Committee will contact potential members to confirm their interest in joining. The Membership Committee and President will then conduct an orientation session and provide a copy of the chapter's Constitution and Bylaws to review the organization's vision and requirements.

To become a member, the candidate must agree to abide by the Constitution and Bylaws and receive a majority vote of approval.

## New members

Membership in Georgia Easy Riders consists of no more than two adults per rig. Other family members may attend camping weekend, participate in all fun activities, dine with us, but may not attend business meetings. They may attend Regional & National Rallies, but will pay an additional fee.

Active voting member status requires one to meet the dues requirement to the local chapter, the Region and to National African American RV Association (NAARVA) and all provisions set forth in the bylaws of this Chapter.

Annual Membership dues are one-hundred and fifty dollars (150.00). Fifty dollars (50.00) of your assessment will be allotted to the yearly operation of the club. One-hundred dollars (\$100.00) of your assessment allotted to our club's biennial anniversary, held in odd-numbered years. The annual dues cover membership for one (1) recreational vehicle (2 members), for one (1) calendar year.
