Over the last year, an Investigation Committee has been meeting to ascertain the viability of extending the school to Years 10 to 12 in coming years. A proposal was put forward to various Church boards and also the Non-State School Accreditation Board. This is a rigorous process that resulted in a submission being lodged in early July. Late last week, we received formal notification giving approval for this proposal. We are absolutely thrilled to be able to give families in the South Burnett another option for their students to complete their senior education at St John's. We know the next few months will be busy as we are offering Year 10 from next year and then following on to Year 11 and 12 in subsequent years.

Thank you to the many church members who have been keeping this process in their prayers. We know this would not proceed if it was not in God's plan and believe that we are privileged to be able to continue to share God's Word with these older students. We look forward to sharing the next steps with you as we prepare for this expansion.
