With the "Voluntary Assisting Dying Bill", that really should be called the Euthanasia and Assisted Suicide Bill, scheduled to be debated and voted on in the parliamentary week commencing Tuesday 14 September, this is a critical rally.

Saturday 11 September, 2021 Meeting at Speakers' Corner, Parliament House, corner Alice & George Streets, Brisbane at 2:30pm for COVID check-in & to collect signs for a 3pm rally. After the rally, a March for Life around the Brisbane CBD (accompanied by police), concluding at Speakers' Corner. We are specifically marching against the Euthanasia and Assisted Suicide Bill, urging our Parliamentarians to reject this extreme and dangerous Bill.
