Parish Service for the Commissioning of Jordan for Word & Sacrament:

Originally postponed from December last year, Bishop Paul Smith will be commissioning Jordan in his ministry among us on **Sunday the 23rd of May, at 9.30 am, at St John's School in Kingaroy.** There will be no services at Kumbia, Wondai, Murgon, Yarraman and Nanango, on the 23rd. Please bring a plate of morning tea to share, which our Kingaroy folk will serve, according to Covid health protocols.

This will be followed by a Parish Meeting at which the audited financial statements and the Final Budget for 2021 will be presented, and the AGM confirmed as per requirements of the constitution.
