## ECSC Nordic Ski Championships to be hosted this weekend at Dewey Mountain

Saranac Lake, NY - (February 14, 2024) The East Coast Ski Conference (ECSC) Regional Championships are set to take place this Saturday and Sunday at Dewey Mountain. This highly anticipated event brings together 16 college ski teams from across the northeast US, competing for a chance to qualify for the USCSA National Championships. Colleges participating include Paul Smith's College, Clarkson University, Cornell, Middlebury, Dartmouth, UVM, University of Maine Farmington, and several other varsity and club programs.

After last week's adverse weather conditions, which left the trails at the original host, Paul Smith's College VIC, in poor condition, the North Country Sports Council, in collaboration with various stakeholders, worked diligently to secure a suitable alternate site. Dewey Mountain, known for its exceptional facilities and picturesque surroundings, graciously stepped up to the plate, already having thrown snow on the trails for the High School championships.

John Thompson, representative of the ECSC, expressed his gratitude, stating, "We are thankful for everyone who helped ensure these races happen. The dedication and effort put forth by the North Country Sports Council and Dewey Mountain have been truly commendable. Extra thanks to the NCSC who has stepped up to financially support this event with accommodations and subsidizing the event costs."

The defending regional champions, Paul Smith's College, are the local favorites and are aiming to secure a three-peat on the men's side. Meanwhile, the women's team is determined to clinch their first-ever title. The competition promises to be fierce, with teams from all over the region vying for the top spots.

"We are thrilled to bring this event to Saranac Lake, showcasing both fierce competition among athletes and inspiring opportunities for our local young skiers. The ECSC championship perfectly aligns with the essence of the North Country and Saranac Lake, reflecting our community's deep love for the outdoors and sports.
