WHAT: Z-Cares Foundation with local sponsorship is hosting a Virtual Coping Carnival on November 14. The Virtual Coping Carnival will feature a day of hope, fun, and meaningful conversation as we wrap up the Stand UP month. The carnival will include local and national personalities, educational and informational segments, surrounded by fun carnival entertainment.
