




- ❖ Module 1: America's Foundation (1681–1865) With history maker: Susanna Warder or Hannah Penn - Exploring William & Hannah Penn, Susanna Warder, George & Martha Washington, Abigail & John Adams, Thomas Jefferson, Benjamin Franklin, Abraham & Mary Todd Lincoln.
- ❖ Module 2: America's First Ladies of the United States (FLOTUS): From Martha to Michelle (1788–2017) - With history maker: Martha Washington or Michelle Obama -Exploring the influence and legacy of 12 First Ladies—from the first to the first African American FLOTUS.
- Module 3: America's Abolitionists (1800s–1865) With history maker: Lucretia Mott, Harriet Tubman, or Frederick Douglass – Exploring Sojourner Truth, William Lloyd Garrison, William Still
- ❖ Module 4: The Women's Suffrage Movement (1840–1920) With history maker: Lucretia Mott or Ida B. Wells – Exploring Elizabeth Cady Stanton, Susan B. Anthony, Alice Paul, Mary Church Terrell
