

RV prep & post care required for boondocking is very time consuming...

Prep: Lubrication/protection of exterior moving parts, full propane tanks, full water tanks, septic treatment, additional stabilization blocks for sand as needed, additional loading time for all things beach related.

Post care: If you have ever cleaned up your car after a day trip to the beach, you understand the time and effort put into cleaning up the RVs after a beach vacation.

Pressure washing of the exterior & underbelly. Washing and re-lubing jacks (and all moving parts), checking electrical components for water exposure and corrosion, change connectors as needed...this is just on the outside!

The corrosive atmosphere is detrimental to the units without proper pre and post care with **EVERY RENTAL**. This fee helps cover some of the man hours involved.
