## DEAR KOOL BOIZ FOUNDATION PARTNERS

Thanks for your support. Here are a few highlights from 2023.

#### Strategic Highlights

The Kool Boiz Foundation made significant changes in our efforts and execution in 2023. Our Promising Men Mentoring program continues to expand with over 30 mentees at Youngstown Community School and Rayan Early College Middle School. We continued our Empowerment Series Mentoring Program with over 150 participants. Three previous scholarship recipients graduated in 2023 and we selected one more \$4,000 college scholarship recipient. We also opened the Kool Boiz Foundation Academic Enrichment Center in 2023.

#### **Financial Highlights**

The Kool Boiz Foundation continued our strong fundraising efforts in 2023. We successfully raised \$84,778 towards our programs and expenses. In addition to the monies raised, we secured several new funding and program partnerships that will allow us to continue our impact.

#### **Event Highlights**

The Kool Boiz Foundation Empowerment Golf Outing launched in 2023 with 72 golfers and over 30 sponsors raising over \$7,200. Our 7<sup>th</sup> Annual Holiday Party with a Purpose was also well attended with nearly 150 people in attendance raising over \$4,000 for our programs.

#### **Looking Ahead**

The Kool Boiz Foundation Academic Enrichment Center is going to be used for expanded mentoring efforts as well as new tutoring and reading programs. Our Promising Men's Mentoring program is also scheduled to expand to three schools in 2024.

#### **History**

The Kool Boiz Foundation was founded in 2015. The organization's Board of Directors consists of current and former residents of Youngstown, Ohio who decided to form an organization with the sole purpose of giving back to the community that helped make them successful. The Kool Boiz Foundation is a 501c3 charitable organization that operates with integrity and complete transparency. Due to our commitment to transparency, we have been awarded the 2023 Platinum Seal of Transparency by Candid. Our impact in the community has been consistently growing since the execution of our first scholarship awarded in 2016, and our first mentoring program in 2016. We are the proud recipients of the United Way of Youngstown and Mahoning Valley Community Impact Award.

## KBF COLLEGE SCHOLARSHIPS

#### Kool Boiz Foundation \$4,000 College Scholarship Award

The Kool Boiz Foundation College Scholarships are awarded to African American males who plan to attend an accredited 2- or 4-year college or university. To apply, applicants must be a resident of Youngstown, be a graduating high school senior, and have a minimum 3.0 GPA. The Kool Boiz Foundation College Scholarship is a \$1,000 4-year renewable scholarship (total award is \$4,000). Award recipients must maintain a 2.0 GPA on a 4.0 scale and be enrolled as a full-time



student at an accredited 2- or 4-year college or university. Scholarship funds are paid directly to the college or university on the student's behalf and are paid in two installments.

In 2023, the Kool Boiz Foundation awarded one new college scholarship, our nineth scholarship awarded. Konner Hines, a graduate of Boardman High School was awarded this year's \$4,000 scholarship. Konner is now attending Baldwin Wallace University.

#### Kool Boiz Foundation \$2,000 Trade School/Non-Credit Scholarship Award

New for 2022, the Kool Boiz Foundation awarded a \$2,000 scholarship to an African American male planning to enroll in a skilled trade or credential program. The criteria for this scholarship is the same as our College Scholarship. This scholarship is for students who plan to earn a skilled trade or credential program (for example, barber school, welding, manufacturing, IT coding, etc.). The scholarship is a one-time award, up to \$2,000 not to exceed the cost of the program, including exam, fees, and credentialing.

We did not award a scholarship in 2023 due to a lack of applicants. The 2023 scholarship will be rolled over to 2024.

## KBF PROMISING MEN MENTORING

#### 2023 Promising Men Mentoring Details



The Kool Boiz Foundation in partnership with the United Way of Youngstown and the Mahoning Valley continues to empower boys and young men of color through our Promising Men Mentoring Program. The program is designed to help young men increase their educational skills, social skills, and leadership skills. In 2023, we continued our in-person 6th, 7th and 8th grade mentoring sessions with 15 mentees at

Youngstown Community School and 15 mentees at Rayen Early College Middle School.

#### Mentoring Makes a Difference

Our mentoring program aims to change the mindsets and behaviors of the young men we serve and help them achieve success in all aspects of their lives. Research shows that youth who have high levels of developmental assistance achieve more and are involved in fewer high-risk behaviors. According to the National Cares Mentoring



Movement, when young people are mentored well, 98% stay in school; 98% do not become teen parents; 85% do not use drugs; and 98% avoid gang participation.

## KBF YOUNG MEN'S EMPOWERMENT CONFERENCE AND MONTHLY SERIES


#### 2023 Young Men's Empowerment Conference and Series Details



Our 3<sup>rd</sup> annual Kool Boiz Foundation Young Men's Empowerment Conference was held Saturday, November 11, 2023, at Eastern Gateway Community College in Youngstown, Ohio. This conference was designed for boys and young men of color in grades 7 through 12 with a goal of exploring long-term success through education, leadership, life skills, and hard work. The conference gave young men an opportunity to hear about and reflect on "What's Possible" through thought-provoking interactive discussions and

workshops. Over 90 participants attended this free conference which ran from 8:00 am to 4:30 pm and included breakfast, lunch, and snacks for all participants.

The Kool Boiz Foundation's Young Men's Virtual Empowerment Conference Series continued in 2023. This series is a 1.5-hour virtual empowerment miniconference held via Zoom on the fourth Saturday of each month. These conferences started in February 2019 and has proven to be a powerful tool in helping the



young men we serve. The conferences are free for participants and incorporate a point system that rewards participates based on their monthly attendance and engagement. In 2023, the virtual conferences averaged 11 participants per month with a total of 36 different boys and young men of color participating.
