CONSECRATED LIFE: LIVING THE BEATITUDES

In today's Gospel, Jesus proposes the Beatitudes to his disciples as a privileged way of life. These "be-attitudes", which reveal the heart and attitudes of Jesus himself, are the pattern on which all Christians are invited to model their lives. The Beatitudes reveal the path to true happiness: poverty of spirit, mercy, purity of heart, gentleness, a deep hunger for justice, courage in the face of opposition. Consecrated life makes these attitudes visible in a radical and joyful way.

On Monday, February 2, the Feast of the Presentation of the Lord, the Church celebrates the **World Day of Consecrated Life**. This day invites us to give thanks for women and men who, through religious vows, offer their lives wholly to God and to the service of His people. Their vocation shines a light on the Gospel values proclaimed by Jesus in the Beatitudes.

Through vows of poverty, chastity, and obedience, through fidelity to the charism and mission of their founders, consecrated persons witness that God alone is sufficient. Their lives remind us that lasting joy is found not in power, possessions or control, but in loving surrender to God's will and dedication to the mission of Christ.

On this feast of light, candles are blessed and carried in procession. The witness of consecrated men and women remind us that Christ is still the light of the world. Their lives encourage all of us, the baptized, to live the Beatitudes in everyday circumstances—with trust, compassion, and hope.

Let us pray in gratitude for those who have already consecrated their lives to God, especially for those religious women and men who have served here at St. Veronica's Parish: Sisters of St. Ann, Sisters of Charity of Halifax, Sisters of the Holy Names of Jesus and Mary, and many others. Let us also ask the Lord to continue calling generous hearts to this beautiful vocation, for the good of the Church and the life of the world.

Reflection on Matthew 5 :1-12

The Beatitudes are the heart of Jesus' teaching. They do not condemn but rather motivate. In a way, they turn our world upside down. Do they do that to me? We pray for the peacemakers and for those who are persecuted, and ask for the grace to see the things going on around us in a new light.
