Dear Parishioners,

It has been exciting to celebrate Public Mass with you at St Veronica's during this Easter season. It has been my goal since the beginning of the Pandemic to celebrate safe & spiritual masses. Deacon Gerry, the Staff, and the Ministers of Liturgy have supported this goal. As the provincial & civic authorities reduce restrictions, I believe, for the time being, there are certain safety procedures that we are going to maintain at St. Veronica's. Covid is still present, we are still in the flu season, and a small number of adult parishioners will come to mass unvaccinated with some family members who are also unvaccinated.

We are continuing to apply these safety measures because a significant number of our parishioners are senior citizens and are considered vulnerable by health authorities.
