Dear Parishioners,

As you know, the government transition the regions of Montreal & Laval on Monday June 14th to a Yellow zone. In the Yellow Zone we are allowed 250 or less participants where you can provide "social distancing". Our Church & choir loft are properly marked for social distancing thus we can only **have approximately 120** (counting the choir loft) for each mass. During the time period of July 10th 2020 to Sept 25th 2020 when these social distancing measures applied we had no problem with the number of parishioners attending the four weekend masses. We will continue to celebrate four weekend masses: 3pm & 4:30pm on Saturday; 9am & 11am on Sunday. As well four weekday masses: Tuesday 7pm, Wednesday 9:15am, Thursday & Friday 9am.
