**Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity May 31,
2026TRINITY: The Power of Love**

At the height of the Cold War, Sir Winston Churchill famously referred to the Soviet Union as “a mystery wrapped in an enigma.” For many Catholics, this is what the doctrine of the Trinity has come to represent: something remote and incomprehensible, taken on faith, but don’t think about it too much! Yet the drive to understand is an irrepressible force within the human spirit. But before we can **understand** something, we have to **experience** it first. If this is true of all knowledge, how much more is it so with Love: the face of infinite Love, far beyond our capacity to grasp.

In today’s celebration of Trinity Sunday, we acknowledge the mystery of Divine Love as pure **gift**: the Father’s love, which takes on human flesh in Jesus, is poured into our hearts through the Holy Spirit. This means that God **is** relationship: God is self-giving love, overflowing on all creation. This also means that **we are not alone**. Look upon creation, and see how the cosmos bears all the marks of the Trinity: dynamic, expansive, giving, radiant; extraordinarily diverse, yet a finely differentiated unity.

As Christians, our faith in the Trinity grounds our belief in the dignity of the human person. We believe that God embraces us, stands in solidarity with us, dwells within us. Created by a loving Father, we are all children of God; redeemed by the Son, we are brothers and sisters of Jesus, and of one another; sanctified by the Holy Spirit, we are Holy Ground, God’s own dwelling place. The Trinity is no dry, dusty dogma, a theoretical construct with no practical application. It is the core truth at the heart of Christian faith: **God is love. God is relationship. God is unity in diversity. God is a communion of equals.** And if this is who God is, then we, created in God’s “image and likeness” must reflect this love, harmony and unity in our own lives.

**Glory to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit;
as it was in the beginning, is now, and ever shall be,
world without end. Amen. Alleluia!**

We're with Nicodemus today and ask him to teach us what he wishes. He appears in our story out of the dark shadows, for he knows only too well that he dare not antagonise his fellow religious leaders. Yet he has an inner honesty that compels him to interrogate Jesus on a number of difficult issues. Evil is darkness, but through Jesus' coming into the world, the power of that darkness is controlled. We ask, Lord, that you continue to keep it at bay for us.
