LOCAL BYLAWS

TEAM

1. Each team will consist of 3 players who are at least 21 years of age and able to prove it. Teams are allowed to carry 4 team members but only 3 play per league match.
2. A minimum of 1 team member (not subs) is required to start a weekly match. You are allowed to have 2 subs for a match.
3. Once a player has started the first set, only that player can play the remaining matches (this also applies for subs). If a player must leave, then every effort should be made to allow all their matches to be played early. That player must then leave the building. If a player cannot stay long enough to complete their matches, then any incomplete matches will be forfeited.
4. A player can be a permanent member of only one league team. We will use a "sub list" – any sub can sub for any team. A sub will be allowed to join another team as a permanent team member. The league can "ignore" a sub one time, otherwise subs must become BCA members.
5. Team captains must identify a sub's first and last name on the scoresheet and indicate who they are subbing for.
6. No new team members or subs may be added beginning with the last 3 weeks of the regular season.

FEES

7. All players, including subs, must purchase a BCA League Membership Card. The annual fee is \$20. The card is valid from January 1st to December 31st.
8. The weekly league fee is \$10. Regular players are responsible for the players' fees or fees for his/her substitute. Games won by the substitute are credited to the regular player on the weekly stats. In Fargo, the games will be credited to the sub.

THE GAME: 10-BALL

9. The format is Round Robin Race to 3 sets.

LOCAL HIGHLIGHTS

A – Lag for the opening break.

B – Rack your own – Template racks (Magic Rack, Turtle Rack, etc.) are optional.

C – Winner breaks.

D – A 10-ball on the break is to be spotted – breaker continues to shoot or “push out.”

E – 3 consecutive foul rule is in effect.

F – Cue ball fouls only.

G – Table run – all 10 balls on the table at the start of your turn – all 10 balls down at the end of your turn will be considered a table run.

H – NO COACHING OR ASSISTANCE OF ANY KIND ALLOWED. First offense will be ball in hand for the opponent – second offense will be loss of match.

I – Fouls may only be called by the 2 shooting players and must be called before the opponent takes his next shot.

J – Jump and Masse shots are allowed, PROVIDED the establishment allows them. Look for a sign or ASK the home team captain if they are allowed. If they are not allowed, and you attempt to shoot them, it will be a ball-in-hand foul.

10. Team standings will be determined in the following order:

A – match wins

B – match sets won

C – total individual games won by the team members

11. The season’s “budget” will be listed on the “weekly Stat Sheet.” Weekly player fees will be used for team prize money, to pay out MVP awards, “added” money to the season ending tournament, “food fund” and “table time” for tournament host location and 10% administration fee to the League Operator.
12. The season-ending double elimination “money added” tournament will be held at the first place team’s establishment.
