Little Storytellers is a narrative language group for primary school aged children. This group utilises 'Supporting Knowledge in Language and Literacy' (SKILL) to help children develop essential narrative language skills. Program Highlights include:

Learning the Art of Storytelling

- Retell and summarise stories with detail
- Explore characters, settings, plot development and sequencing of a story
- Identify character's thoughts, feelings and perspectives
- Understand and use questions, prepositions, adjectives, adverbs, coordinated and subordinated conjunctions, determiners and elaborated noun phrases.
- Identify real-life connections between words and their use

Connecting with Peers

- Foster social interaction and cooperation.
- Develop teamwork and communication skills.
- Build friendships with other children.



Cost

- \$161.65 per session
