About the program

Little School Starters is a group program for children enrolled to commence foundation at a mainstream primary school in 2026.

This is a strengths-based, neurodiversity affirming group, run by Speech Pathologists and Occupational Therapists at a ratio of one therapist to three participants. It is designed to support your child with essential school readiness skills.



Program Highlights

- Understand school routines, develop independence skills & organise belongings: Learn to pack and unpack school bags, ask for help, manage a lunchbox, visit the toilet & keep track of belongings.
- Group Time: Explore stories, discuss plans for the day, practise asking questions and play 'show & share!'
- Transition Skills: Practise moving from one task to another.
- Fine & Gross Motor skills: Build on drawing, writing, cutting, pasting and necessary gross motor skills.
- Interaction with peers: Eat lunch with peers, participate in outdoor play with peers and build social
 connection and conflict resolution skills.
- Specialist Classes: Explore exciting subjects like Art, Music, Science, and PE
- And Much More: Boost confidence, creativity, and communication skills.
