Remember: this is about exploring, not deciding today.

Quick Reminders	
Visit 3 booths max (quality over quantity)	<ol> <li>2.</li> <li>3.</li> </ol>
Jot down notes	<ul> <li>Program/School:</li> <li>3 Things I liked:</li> <li>3 Things I didn't:</li> <li>Follow-up Q's:</li> </ul>
Notice the vibe (As much as the Info)  ie.  - Does the campus feel safe & welcoming?  - Do students look happy, stressed, or rushed?  - Can you imagine yourself here?  - Is there an energy buzzing, calm, or somewhere in between?	
Questions to Ask:	<ol> <li>What makes this program different?</li> <li>What supports are available for students?</li> <li>How easy is it to switch programs?</li> <li>What do grads usually do after graduation?</li> <li>What's the student vibe like here?</li> </ol>

*If Parents Come:	<ul> <li>YOU (teen) ask the first question</li> <li>They (parent) add only one follow-up.</li> <li>Suggest splitting up + compare notes</li> </ul>
After the Open House:	<ul> <li>Circle (or highlight) your top 2 options to research more</li> <li>Talk about what <b>felt right</b>, just the facts.</li> <li>One event does not = final decision.</li> </ul>
