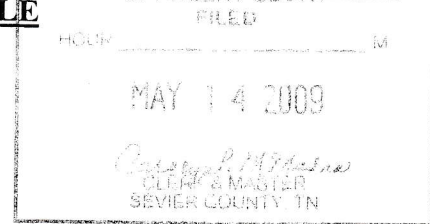

NOTICE

Notice is hereby given pursuant to the "Order Certifying Class" entered by the Honorable Telford E. Forgety, Jr., Chancellor for Sevier County, Tennessee, that the above captioned action has been commenced in the Chancery Court for Sevier County, Tennessee by the Shields Mountain Property Owners Association, Inc., Jonathan Bourne and Terrie Hall, as individual lot owners, requesting that the Court enter a judgment or appropriate Order allowing the property owners within the Shields Mountain Estates Subdivision the equitable means to amend the "Shields Mountain Estates Protective Covenants and Restrictions" of record in Misc. Book 45, Page 67 in the Register's Office of Sevier County, Tennessee, and adopt reasonable procedures and requirements to accomplish the same or, alternatively, that the Court judicially reform or amend the

Covenants and Restrictions in order to correct inherent flaws in the instrument. The Court has certified as a "Defendant Class" all property owners within the Shields Mountain Estates Subdivision and other parties of interest by virtue of holding mortgages or trust deeds on property within the subdivision.

Notice is hereby further given that *a hearing* shall be conducted to consider and rule upon the Plaintiffs' requested relief on August 25, 2009, commencing at nine a.m. in the Chancery Courtroom, Sevier County Courthouse, Sevierville, Tennessee. Members of the Defendant Class may, but are not required to: (1) Appear at the hearing with or without counsel; (2) hire legal counsel; (3) consent or object to the requested relief; (4) contact the *Attorney Ad Litem* or attorney for the Plaintiffs for further inquiry.

The Court has appointed an *Attorney Ad Litem* to represent the Defendant Class, whose name, address and telephone number is as follows:


