Court Usage

With the addition of Pickleball and Youth Tennis Instruction the PLCTC board has decided on the following court usage priorities.

Carrying your Membership Card with you gives you first priority on open courts. Guests or Non-members may use courts only when no members are waiting.

Point Loma Park Courts off Catalina Blvd. are reserved for recreational Tennis only. Instruction and Pickleball are not allowed on these courts.

1. Singles - limited to 1 hour.
2. Doubles limited to 90 minutes.
3. Individual practice allowed only if no member is waiting.
4. Please wait outside until courts are available.
5. At least two people must be present to claim a court.

Cabrillo Rec Center courts off Canon St. are available for tennis instruction, pickleball, and recreational tennis following these usage priorities:

1. Cabrillo Elementary School has priority on school days and **occasionally** plan student activities during school hours. If there are no students present on the courts they are open to PLCTC members.
2. Tennis instruction by officially sanctioned club instructors (their schedules are posted by the gate)
3. Pickleball members will receive monthly copies of court availability schedules and any changes to the gate and equipment lock combinations via email.
4. Recreational Tennis
5. IMPORTANT: If no other players are on the courts when you are leaving **LOCK THE GATE!**

Court Care

No bicycling, skateboarding, rollerblading, or skating on the courts please. Pickleball only at Cabrillo Courts please.

Only tennis shoes are allowed. Please, no hard or black-soled shoes!

Please respect the courts, nets, windscreens, seating, and shade structures.

Keep area clean.

Code of Conduct

The PLCTC board recently adopted a code of conduct. Most Tennis and Pickleball clubs around the city have similar codes. We ask that as members you agree to abide by this code, which basically requests that you behave with civility and respect for all members and guests of the club.

Our mission is to create an environment where all players are treated equally, sportsmanship is more important than wins and losses, competition is strong but not relentless and people are more important than the game.

Code of Conduct

- I will exhibit fairness and honesty in my dealings with others.
- I will treat others with respect.
- I will exemplify the highest standard in ethical behavior and fair play.
- I will treat all club property with respect, and clean/tidy up after any court activity.
- I will always control my temper on and off the court.

Unacceptable actions include, but are not limited to:

- Discourteous, crude, or offensive behavior
- Yelling at any player, member, or guest of the club
- Intimidating, threatening, bullying, or exhibiting any other aggressive or abusive behavior toward any player, member, or guest of the club
- Obscene language or gestures
- Overly aggressive play towards any player

It is everyone's responsibility to make new players feel welcome.

Violations of the Code of Conduct may result in sanctions and/or disciplinary action under the PLCTC Membership Disciplinary and Appeal Procedure available on the PLCTC website.
