We are looking forward to another great year. This past year has seen continued growth in membership, continued association with the San Diego Tennis Center, and good utilization of the teaching opportunities we offer. As a result of these associations and your participation and membership, we have made significant improvements to our facilities.

Court Improvements

The four tennis courts on Catalina Boulevard (behind the Fire Station) received much-needed new wind screens. Soon our club logo will be appearing on those courts.

The two tennis courts at Cabrillo Rec Center were completely resurfaced over the summer. The entire job was completed in one week by a local company called Court Tech. The courts look great, and added to the western-most court are lines for four beautiful pickleball courts.

Court Improvements (cont'd)

The four pickleball courts are available to our members and their guests. The Cabrillo courts are secured by a combination lock. Members will be notified by email whenever a change is made to the combination. Access to these courts is included in your membership. Pickleball and tennis players with paid memberships will receive the information necessary to gain access to the courts and equipment via email. Pickleball Enthusiasts

All levels of players are welcome and encouraged to come and join this growing group at our club. We ask that all players be kind and tolerant of one another regardless of your skill. And PLEASE, if you have friends that are interested in pickleball, encourage them to join the club and fill out a membership application. A QR code is posted at the courts, so it is easy for "newbies" to join and pay their dues with a smart phone and a few clicks.

Tennis and Pickleball Instruction

Currently, our club sanctions instruction in tennis and in pickleball throughout the week on our Cabrillo courts only. No instruction is sanctioned on the Catalina courts. Those courts are for tennis playing only! If you notice instruction occurring on the Catalina courts, members are to ask the instructors to leave and to contact the board members, if they want to be sanctioned to teach. Private and/or group instruction and summer camps are available. If you are interested in instruction, please contact one of these sanctioned entities:

Court Usage

With the addition of pickleball and youth tennis instruction, the PLCTC board has established the following court usage priorities:

Carrying your membership card with you gives you first priority on open courts. Cards are available to paid members by calling Mike Moser (619-223-0887). Guests or non-members may use courts only when no members are waiting.

<u>Point Loma Park courts</u> off Catalina Boulevard are reserved for <u>recreational tennis only</u>. Instruction and pickleball are not allowed on these courts.

<u>Cabrillo Rec Center courts</u> off Canon Street are available for tennis instruction, recreational tennis, and pickleball, following these usage priorities:

1. Tennis instruction by officially sanctioned club instructors. (Schedules are posted by the gate.)

2. Pickleball members will receive monthly copies of court availability schedules and any changes to the gate and equipment lock combinations via email.

3. Recreational tennis is available when there is a court not in use by sanctioned instructors or pickleball players. Again, check the schedule posted by the entrance gate.

4. IMPORTANT: If no other players or instructors are on the courts when you are leaving, please **LOCK THE GATE** !

5. PLCTC allows 6 guests per year per member. Repeating guests should be encouraged to join the club.

Time on the courts for all locations:

- 1. Singles play is limited to one hour.
- 2. Doubles play is limited to 90 minutes.
- 3. Individual practice is allowed only if no member is waiting.
- 4. Please wait outside until courts are available.
- 5. At least two people must be present to claim a court.

Court Care

- 1. No bicycling, skateboarding, rollerblading, or skating is allowed on the courts.
- 2. Only tennis shoes are allowed. Please, no hard-soled or black-soled shoes.
- 3. Please respect the courts, nets, windscreens, seating, and shade structures.
- 4. Keep all areas clean.

Code of Conduct

The PLCTC board recently adopted a code of conduct. Most tennis and pickleball clubs around the city have similar codes. We ask that as members you agree to abide by this code, which basically requests that you behave with civility and respect for all members and guests of the club.

Our mission is to create an environment where all players are treated equally, sportsmanship is more important than wins and losses, competition is strong but not relentless, and people are more important than the game.

Code of Conduct

- · I will exhibit fairness and honesty in my dealings with others.
- · I will treat others with respect.
- · I will exemplify the highest standard in ethical behavior and fair play.
- · I will treat all club property with respect, and clean/tidy up after any court activity.
- \cdot I will always control my temper on and off the court.

Unacceptable actions include, but are not limited to, the following:

- · Discourteous, crude, or offensive behavior.
- · Yelling at any player, member, or guest of the club.
- Intimidating, threatening, bullying, or exhibiting any other aggressive or abusive behavior toward any player, member, or guest of the club.
- · Obscene language or gestures.
- · Overly aggressive play towards any player.

It is everyone's responsibility to make new players feel welcome. Violations of the Code of Conduct may result in sanctions and/or disciplinary action under the PLCTC Membership Disciplinary and Appeal Procedure available on the PLCTC website.
