was definitely a success right from the beginning. But the beginning was not Thursday, June 22; oh no for the BOI it started weeks before with the National Office crew verifying paperwork, making sure all waivers were in, printing and sorting tickets, etc. Then on Wednesday, June 21, t-shirts, staff shirts, unit packets, and tickets were sorted to get ready for pick up. On Thursday there was a large contingency waiting for the Ride2Camp

bikers to arrive at the hotel. They were expected at noon, then 1:00, 1:30, 2:00, my gosh what else could go wrong for them. But finally just before 2:30 they pulled in to the Clarion Hotel in Cedar Rapids to cheers, waves and toasts (and I don't mean bread). But no rest as many had to get over to the Scottish Rite Temple to begin setting up for the Opening Ceremony, "American Sokol's Got Talent" where Traditions met new technology. I thought it was a very touching Flag Ceremony where the Old American Sokol Flag was carried out then our new flag made its debut with the old one being officially retired. Thanks to all who came out to watch this show; we had a packed house! Right after the Opening Ceremony many stayed around to socialize, meet up with old friends and begin new friendships.

Friday was also a very busy day with both Volleyball and Fitness Challenge events at the Iowa Sports Arena. There were over 220 fitness competitors. We had six men and five women's VB teams playing their hearts out. Watching some of those men's matches, I was certainly glad I was not playing against them they had some awesome hard hitting spikes — YIKES. Our Men's Championship went to Sokol Tabor and our Women's Championship is Sokol Spirit White Team. But wait day is not over yet. There was a Teen Social at the Clarion where the group enjoyed karaoke, games, pictures and of course socializing. While this was going on so too was the Sokol Banquet.

Saturday was our day for gymnastic competitions at Sokol Cedar Rapids with three female sessions and one male session for a total of over 225 gymnasts. Saturday evening was our Victory Dance with over 500 in attendance where all had fun catching up with Sokol friends, dancing to music by a DJ.

Things were winding down by then with the Closing Ceremony rehearsals and program. And an awesome program it was. Numbers moved on and off the field with minimal lag time. Our program started off with General Assembly being led off with our National Flags; right behind them was a contingent of six Western District members carrying the large flag that was flown in 1994 over the Strahov Stadium in Prague. Next came our new American Sokol Flag followed by Sokol USA flag with their respective lodges, Sokol Canada and Sokol Toronto as well as DA Sokol and the Moravian Cultural Society who had members participating in our Folk Dance number. Next came Central District with their Unit flags, Eastern District and their units, Northeastern District and units, Southern District and units; and our host Western District and their units. Filling up the middle column were all our Folk Dancers in costume. Other columns were filled by members from all Classes; children, juniors and adults. So impressive to see the numbers out on the field beginning with the Children Calisthenics, followed by the Folk Dance. Next was our Tug of War – with teams from Sokol USA, DA Sokol, Central District, Northeastern District and Western District with our 2017 Tug of War Champs being the Central District. Next on the program was our Junior Calisthenics, Sr. II Cal, Adult Cal then the Relay Race with Sokol USA, Northeastern District, Central District, DA Sokol, and Western District. The winner of the Relay Race was the Northeastern District. The last number on the program was the All Sokols number with gymnasts from Tots to Senior II participating – a very impressive way to end this program. Hmmm, wonder who will step up to host the National Slet in 2021?

We have lawn chairs available, but you are welcome to bring your own if you like. No alcohol or smoking allowed.
