Sokol Hosts Successful Gymnastics Competition



Sokol Gymnastics in Ennis is preparing for Fall class registration after hosting their "Slet" Competitions for the Southern District of the American Sokol Organization. Competing were 109 Texas gymnasts from Ennis, Dallas, Fort Worth, Houston and West. Ennis last hosted this event in 2014, making it a very special weekend for this local organization.

The three-day event began with a volleyball tournament on Friday evening, when Ennis Sokol fielded two teams that won first and second place. All day Saturday featured the gymnastics competition for both girls and boys from Novice through Level 9. Girls competed in uneven parallel bars, balance beam, vault and floor exercise. Boys competed in parallel bars, horizontal bar, rings, vault, pommel horse and floor exercise. Sunday events began in the early moring with track and field games that included races, frisbee and javelin (pool noodle) tosses. After lunch, the grand finale program featured a concert by the Dallas Czech Concert Orchestra, performance by the Ennis Czech Beseda Dancers, a mass calisthenics performance by all the competing gymnasts, special tumbling numbers prepared by the various Sokol units, concluding with presentation of awards for the previous day's competition.

Sokol focuses on recreational gymnastics in a wholesome, family friendly environment, where even beginners can enjoy learning the same skills that Olympic gymnasts must master. Their preschool class minimum age is three. Sokol also offers Zumba for active adults and low impact exercise for senior citizens who range well into their 80s.

Pre-registration for fall classes will be held August 5 and 12 at the Sokol gymnasium at 2622 E. Hwy. 34. Gymnastics classes will begin the evening of August 26. Registration packets can be downloaded from the www.sokolennis.com website or picked up at the Sokol swimming pool.

About 1 am on Friday July 19, Sokol Elite Bartender Jessica Trojacek was passing by the hall and noticed the damaged fireworks sand. The vehicle had been moved closer to the all Hall but the driver was nowhere to be found. Jessica called the Sheriff's office who responded to the scene and impounded the pickup.

As it turned out, the Chevy pickup and another vehicle were stolen by two or more bad guys who had burglarized a home in Ennis. It's speculated that the driver was picked up by his partners in crime and escaped the scene.

The power to building has been discounted by Oncor and the area is safe. As of press time the incident is still under investigation and perpetrators have not been captured.


