Educational Director's Report Local Sokol Leaders

Bernice Frances Jurcik Hamilton

1934 - 2021

This "Local Sokol Leaders" series highlights our local Sokols who were instrumental in keeping the Sokol and Czech spirit alive here. These articles will reminisce for our older members and introduce our newer members to those they may never have known, who dedicated their lives to this organization.

Bernice began gymnastics at age 10. She drilled (practices gymnastics) here at Sokol KHB Ennis and at Sokol Zizka Dallas, where she would spend the night with her uncle and aunt nearby. She became an adult member in 1951 at age 17. She met her future husband Harrell Hamilton at Sokol when she bounced a ball off his head. After marrying, Harrell's college and army days took Bernice away from Texas. Upon returning after his military service, the young family settled in Fort Worth, where they became active in Sokol Fort Worth with gymnastics and dancing the Beseda.



In 1972, the Hamiltons moved to Italy, Texas. Bernice and her family, all 7 of them began either teaching or working out at Sokol KHB Ennis and competing in Southern District and National Slets. Bernice wrote and taught several award-winning rhythmic, gymnastic "Special Numbers." Among them were the Southern District Special Number, "Sokol Round-Up," that won First Place at the 1973 National Slet in Chicago. She wrote a special prostna (calisthenics) for tots, which involved stuffed animals. She also judged apparatus and Special Number routines at District Slets.



She was a member of the organizing team for the founding of the Sokol West Gymnastic Association. Bernice served as the treasurer for both the American Sokol Southern District and Sokol KHB for many years, as well as being assistant Director of Women in Ennis. Post her official positions, she continued to attend many Southern District annual meetings and ASO National Conventions as a delegate.

Bernice taught gymnastics classes into the late 1980s, finally retiring from coaching after 20 years. But she did not retire from Sokol. She continued to be an integral member of Sokol's kitchen crew. She led the kolache baking for decades, baking thousands of kolache for Polka Festival and the Junior Sokol Gymnastics annual bake sale. During the bake sales, she taught many a Sokol mother, dad and child the fine art of kolache baking. In addition, Bernice helped the Sokol kitchen prepare for Polka Festival by making at least 100 Czech dumplings (knedliky) and gallons and gallons of sauerkraut in a gravy base (kisely zeli).

American Sokol Organization Honors Rhonda Liska

The American Sokol Organization has presented KHB member, Rhonda Liska, the Jindrich Fugner Service Award for her many years of dedicated service.



Rhonda Liska is a lifetime member of Sokol Karel Havlicek Borovsky. At age 10, she started in its gymnastic program and participated in her first American Sokol Slet in 1977. In addition, she was lifeguard at the Sokol KHB Tyrs pool, played volleyball as a teen and adult and attended instructor schools and numerous District, National, and International Slets.

Rhonda served as Sokol KHB Director of Women from 1989 to 1994 and was a member of the Board of Trustees for 8 years. At the district level, she has been the Southern District Secretary since 1987. Rhonda was Secretary of the American Sokol from 2000-2005 and has been on the National ASO Executive Board as Bylaws Chairman since 2018. Having participated in many American Sokol national conventions, she served as secretary in 1990 and represented the Southern District on the Convention Bylaws Committee where she was

secretary in 1995, 2000, 2005, 2010, and 2014. Rhonda continues as Southern District Secretary as well as serving on the National Membership and Bylaws Committees. Rhonda is a Certified Professional Landman in the Oil and Gas Industry and holds a Master of Jurisprudence from Texas A&M School of Law.


Doors Open 6pm / Accordion Music by David Slovak 6:30pm Featured Film: "To Catch a Millionaire" 7pm
