"Symbolically: The Czech flag waves proudly with Red, White and Blue colors rich in the ideas of democracy. The flag contains a common gift, Sunflowers grown in regions of the Czech Republic. Sunflowers are known to rise up and look to the path of the sun following it as it progresses through time. These Sunflowers are not cut flowers, which could only be seen and admired for a brief time. These flowers are alive and are rooted. They can survive and flourish with care. Their roots are held tightly in a container which poses the brand of the Sokol Organization. There is significance to Sokol, in that Sokol holds dear these roots of Freedom, Family, Fitness and Fairness through democracy. This gift was planted in America in 1865. In times it has flourished spreading roots and seeding the land and in other times it has shown attrition. However, Sokol has never lost its roots; they have been securely planted in America. The small American Flag is placed in with these roots and ideas. The Sokol holds America dear containing a commonality with the Czech people as well as all peoples who desire Freedom, Family, Fitness and Fairness. NAZDAR!"

Rome Milan (January 29, 1959 - April 23, 2021). Rome, a native of Fort Worth, was born into Sokol, and made a huge imprint in the world of gymnastics and American Sokol. As an avid gymnastic historian, he curated a vast collection of vintage Sokol and Olympic memorabilia which he and his father, Jerry Milan, would pack up and take to gymnastic meets all over the country, educating the public about the Sokol mission and its history. They did this at their own expense. Two years ago this month, Rome lost his battle with ALS (Lou Gehrig's Disease).


Chicken Fried Steak Feast & Live Music by Studebakers April 28th

About the film: A drama about three young adults in Most, Czech Republic that sort out feelings and responsibilities: Monika's boyfriend has left for the States, her mother wants her to join him there, and if the invitation does come, what should she do? Toník is a nice guy, his love for Moni is unrequited. He's trying to rebuild his family's crumbling house; a nearby factory has made an offer to buy the land. With Moni, he watches out for the two young sons of Dasha, their friend who's in a hopeless long-term affair with a married man: Dasha is at once unstable, unrealistic, neglectful of her boys, and cruel to those who help. For whom is this something like happiness?
