Local Sokol Units Supported by the American Sokol Organization and the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Czech Republic

Sokol KHB received 3 internal grants from the American Sokol Foundation this year. We are grateful for all the support that the ASO Endowment Foundation and the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Czech Republic has provided our unit and all American Sokol units nationwide as we struggled through these Covid pandemic years. We are implementing these improvements for unit sustainment and unit growth that were partially funded by these grant funds:

- Three Point of Sale (POS) systems that will be used for the Tyrs swimming pool, the bar and kitchen, and in the gym. As our physical programs, pool usage and event rentals grow, POS systems will help expedite sales and admission transactions and improve communication from these to our accounting system.
- Floor Scrubbing Machine to replace our old, non-functioning floor scrubber. This new machine and associated sanitizing products will ensure that our facility floors are properly cleaned for our physical programs after large social events.
- Covid-related cleaning supplies to keep our gym areas, gymnastics equipment, equipment associated with other programs, and restrooms sanitized to comply with required regulations to prevent the spread of Covid-19 and its variants.

Educational Director's Report

Our Special Painting



This 3-1/2-foot X 4 x1/2-foot oil on canvas was painted by artist and Sokol Fort Worth member Henrietta Milan in 1991 and presented to our Sokol KHB Museum as it was being reorganized in the new hall. Everyone who visits our Sokol KHB Ennis library / museum sees the artwork prominently displayed on the back wall facing the entrance. While the image is patriotic and inspiring, few know the significance and symbolism behind the work.

The inspiration for Henrietta's artwork was a circa 1920 postcard commemorating the American Sokols who traveled to Prague, Czechoslovakia for the 1920 All-Sokol Slet (International gathering). This was the 7th International Slet since the founding of the Sokol

organization, but it was the first Slet following the creation of the new nation of Czechoslovakia after World War I. The Slet was attended by more than 500,000 people. Events leading up to the competition lasted three weeks, while the competitions spanned five days. More than 100,000 members actively participated in a parade, competitions and prostna (mass calisthenics).

The central figures, a man and woman in Sokol uniforms of that era, stand before the US flag with the US capital on the right side. They are looking toward a distant image of Prague Castle on the left side, anticipating the trip they were about to take. In her hand, the woman holds a cluster of Linden leaves. The Linden tree is still the national tree of both the Czech Republic and Slovakia. Its heart-shaped leaves have long been a symbol of righteousness, peace, love, prosperity, friendship, and good luck. The man holds the staff of the US flag in his left hand and a sword in the down position in his right, signifying willingness to protect the USA, just as the falcon protects its domain. Filling the sky is a flock of falcons (sokols) flying toward and around the US capitol dome. They represent all the Sokols who had immigrated to America and brought their culture with them.

About the film: A drama about Adam, a young farmer. As a child, fleeing the bleak reality of his mother's life as a prostitute, he tumbled from a mountain and was mentally injured. Years later, his mother is dying, so Adam sells their only cow to pay for medicine. Rosa, a beautiful young maid, fleeing the sexual exploitation of a wealthy butcher, climbs up to join them on their remote farm and dares to become part of Adam's world. A cycle of life begins again, in a remote turn-of-the-century village tied to the land and its animals.
