

Educational Director's Report Czech Christmas Traditions

The Czech holiday season begins December 6 on Svatý Mikuláš (St. Nicholas Day). The baking of Christmas candies and sweets (Vánoční Cukroví) commences. Family recipe treats are baked to share with friends and neighbors. If there were any quarrels or hard feelings during the year, this is the time to apologize.

Because Christmas is a religious holiday, fasting and abstaining from meat were observed on Christmas Eve. Traditionally, the Christmas Eve dinner main course is carp. One popular recipe has the best cuts of the carp dredged in flour, dipped in egg wash, then in bread crumbs and fried. Carp is a bottom feeding fish common in Europe, and has a muddy flavor. That sounds a lot like our catfish, which makes fried catfish a good substitute for the Czech traditional carp dinner. Some keep a couple of the carp's scales in their wallets for good financial luck. In some families, it is a custom to put a coin under each person's plate to symbolize wealth in the coming year. The coin will be carried around for good luck. Another tradition says that if you have fasted properly on Christmas Eve, you might be able to see the golden pig. If you do, you will be prosperous in the coming year. Another traditional food is vánočka, a sweet bread filled with dried fruit and nuts, eaten on Christmas Eve.



The Christmas tree tradition is different from in the U.S. The tree, purchased only a few days before Christmas (*not on Thanksgiving weekend*), is hidden away in the home and decorated only by the head of the household. No one else is allowed to see it until after the Christmas Eve dinner. During the dinner, no one is allowed to leave the table. While everyone is eating, the tree and gifts "miraculously" appear into the main room. After dinner, everyone wishes each other a Joyous Christmas (Šťastné a Veselé Vánoce). They rush to the tree and distribute the gifts before going to midnight mass. Ježíšek (Baby jesus), not Santa Claus brings the gifts.

The Christmas Day feast features a roasted goose, chicken soup, dumplings, kolache and other sweets. Because Christmas is a sacred day, no chores are done. The families socialize and play games, speculating on what the next year would bring for each other's fortunes and love lives.

During the communist era, religious aspects of holidays were discouraged, and Christmas was not officially recognized as a public holiday. However, many Czechs continued to celebrate the holiday in secret. After the fall of communism in 1989, Christmas was again recognized as a public holiday. Today, Christmas in the Czech Republic is celebrated with most of the same traditions as in other countries. While Ježíšek (Baby Jesus), always brought the gifts, even during the communist era (*shhh!*), Czechs are now trying to keep the commercial Santa Claus out as he creeps into everything.
