






Educational Director's Report

"Slet" defined: A gathering of Sokols for competitions, athletic exhibitions, mass calesthenics, and socializing. During the summer every 6 years, usually the first week of July, Sokols from all over the world gather in Prague. The event is called the Všesokolský (All-Sokols) Slet. There are 15 nations in the World Sokol Federation. Here in the USA, we have District Slets in the Spring every year, and National Slets every 4 years. The American Sokol National Slets are usually held in Chicago or another Midwestern city; however, Fort Worth hosted the National Slet in 2009.



This is the year for the Všesokolský in Prague. Thousands of Sokols worldwide have spent months learning routines of kaleidoscopic mass calisthenics, called



"Prostna" in their own unit gyms from written instructions sent out last year. Once in Prague, they will gather to rehearse all together — over 1,000 participants for each routine. There are different "Prostna" for children, for youth, adult women, adult men, and seniors. It takes a few days of rehearsal for more than 1,000 people at a time to put together the geometric patterns they have been learning in small groups at home.

There were no All-Sokol Slets between 1948 and 1994 due to Communist Party rule during that time. These are pictures of the

adult womens' and adult mens' Prostna (mass calisthenics) programs in 2018.

"This was a true Miracle," said Ray. "If you are going to have a medical emergency, what better place than with medical professionals in the building." 




Monthly Czech Movie & Social June 6th
