## Ennis Sokol Karel Havlíček Borovský Recognized

On Saturday, May 9, 2026, Sokol KHB Ennis was recognized by the Ellis County & Texas Historical Commissions for our impact on Texas history, culture and heritage.

Sokol KHB Ennis President, Michelle Slovak, shared about Sokol's history during the dedication ceremony.

“In the 19<sup>th</sup> century, an influx of Czech immigrants migrated through Galveston to Texas seeking a better life lured by the prime farmland on the Blackland Prairie. With them, they brought their farming practices, religion, language and their cultural institutions from the homeland. One such institution was the establishment of strong fraternal and social organizations to retain our cultural heritage...Several Czech families who settled near Ennis around the turn of the century formed Sokol Karel Havlíček Borovský (“Sokol KHB”) in 1908, the first Sokol state unit in Texas, which has celebrated 118 years of continuous gymnastics training and is a center for ethnic identity for local Czech descendants...

A physical, educational and cultural organization, Sokol is the only Czech related organization formed in the United States that had its beginning in the old country.”



As we dedicated the Undertold Marker, we paid tribute to those Czech immigrants, their Ennis descendants and the impact Sokol KHB has made to Ellis County and Texas culture. In April 1908, Sokol KHB, was named after the beloved Czech patriot, Karel Havlíček, from the village of Borová. Twenty-five charter members formed the unit and the first president, Alois Jurcik, was an immigrant to Ennis from Moravia. The unit was accepted in April 1909 into the National Union Sokol (now American Sokol).

Recognized as the first and oldest gymnastics club in Texas, gymnastics continues to be the backbone of our organization with our gymnastics program participating in exhibitions and “Slets” annually. From the first district competition in Granger in 1910 all the way to the new Czech Republic in 1994, Sokol has provided instruction in calisthenics, floor exercises, rhythmic gymnastics, tumbling, pyramid building, twirling, volleyball and swimming.



In addition to athletic programs, Sokol KHB continues to promote Czech culture and heritage through participation in festivals such as Czech Music Festival and the National Polka Festival, preservation of history and ancestry in our Sokol Museum & Library, sponsorship and participation of Česká Beseda dance classes and monthly Social & Czech Movie Nights from the Czech Heritage Society.



Sokol KHB strives to continue to provide fitness and community for individuals and family through physical, educational, cultural and social programs throughout the Ennis community. As President Michelle Slovak said, “For over a century, Ennis Sokol Karel Havlíček Borovský has continued to fulfill the motto adopted by Sokols worldwide of a “healthy mind in a healthy body” and provide a link to our native land.

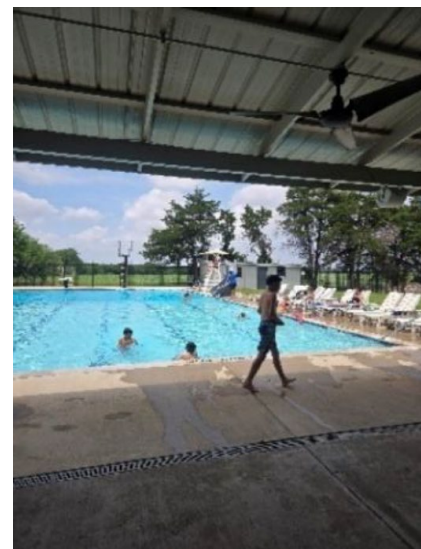

## Sokol Ennis Awarded ASO Grants

Sokol KHB Ennis received four American Sokol Foundation grants this year for the following improvement programs:

- **“Unit Growth grant #1”** for a Neighborhood Pool Party -- \$2,040 (*Held May 16*)
- **“Unit Growth grant #2”** for a National Night Out Party -- \$1,909 (*Planned for October 6, 2026*)
- **“Unit Corporate Sustainability”** grant for a new POS system for the Club Room -- \$1,320 (*Purchased*)
- **“Gateway to the Future”** grant for the purchase of additional file cabinets and display cases for the museum -- \$870 (*Still in planning*)

We thank the American Sokol Foundation for these wonderful grants to improve our facility and help grow our membership. All of these grants have been supplemented with awards through the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Czech Republic from applications made by the American Sokol Organization Foundation.

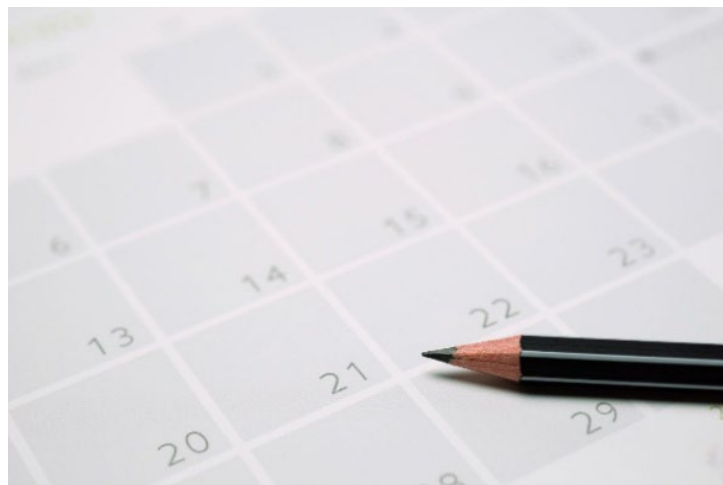

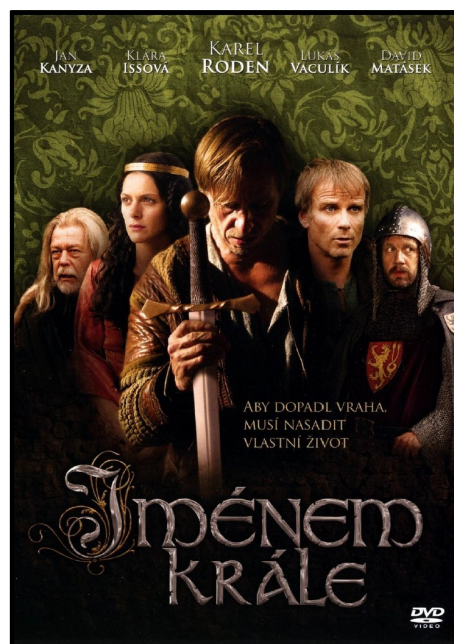
