Tour starts with entry to The Hammond House. The current owner (a descendent of Fannie Lee Hammond) shares fascinating stories of hidden secrets and history. A centerpiece to Calvert's Historic District, and listed on The Library of Congress Historic American Buildings Survey, enjoy viewing exhibits displaying Calvert's rich history before taking the bus and heading over to another unique landmark, the Church of the Epiphany (Episcopal Church), the oldest church edifice erected in Calvert. Next, ride the bus to Calvert's Historic Downtown, where the guided portion of our tour ends. Continue your trip, enjoying 8-blocks of architectural landmark, various shops, and eateries on Main Street before heading back to Harris County.

Start: HAMMOND HOUSE Exhibit (45 min)

Stop 2: Episcopal Church Tour with historic pipe organ (20 min)

Stop 3: Walk Calvert's Historic Downtown and/or enjoy lunch on your own at local eateries (call for list). (2+ hours)
