




The 7 Layers of a Food Forrest



The Seven Layers of a Fruit Forest

1. The Canopy Layer
2. The Understory Layer
3. The Shrub Layer
4. The Herbaceous Layer
5. The Root Layer
6. The Ground Cover Layer
7. The Vine Layer

The 7 Layers of a Food Forest:

1. The Canopy Layer – large fruit and nut trees
2. The Understory Layer – smaller fruit trees
3. The Shrub Layer – currant and berry bushes
4. The Herbaceous Layer – herbs
5. Rhizosphere (Root) Layer – root vegetables
6. Ground Cover Layer – ground cover plants
7. Vertical (or Vine) Layer – vines and climbers
