

How to make a submission about Peninsula Precinct

Important information to note

The process being applied to assess the Peninsula Precinct development application is **different** to the standard process managed by the Federal Environment Department. For this case, public commenting on this stage is being managed by the project proponent, Springfield City Group. Background

All submissions made must relate to the aspects of the EPBC Act that are assessed. Only Matters of National Environmental Significance (MNES) are of interest. In the case of Woogaroo Forest, this includes KOALAS, Grey-Headed Flying Foxes, Swift Parrots (seen seasonally in the area), Regent Honeyeaters (seen seasonally in the area), Migrants such as Rufous Fantail, Black-faced Monarch, Spectacled Monarch, Rainbow Bee-eater and White-throated Needletail.

If you know anything else that the EPBC might find to be of interest, then please make sure to include it.

Here is a page that <u>lists the flora and fauna</u> protected under the EPBC Act.

Key points to note

- o The public is only given **until 16 December** to make a submission
- Each person/entity can only send in <u>one</u> submission each
- o Submissions can be emailed to peninsula@springfieldqld.au

- You MUST state in your submission that this is a controlled action
- All submissions must be received by 5pm Tuesday 16 December 2025.
